Guidelines for Fee Payment

IIIT Pune accepts admission fees only through online SBI Collect except for those students who are paying fees through educational loan. There are several options available in SBI Collect to pay the fees.

General Initial Procedure

Open the link: <http://www.onlinesbi.com/sbicollect/icollecthome.htm?corpID=962167> , select the checkbox and press 'Proceed' button.

Or

Go to website <https://www.onlinesbi.com/> and select 'SBI Collect' tab, select checkbox and press 'Proceed' button. On next page, select 'Maharashtra' State from drop-box, and then select 'Educational Institutions' from drop-box. Press 'Go' button. Type and select 'Indian Institute of Information Technology Pune' from drop-box and then press 'Submit' button.

Filling-up Mandatory Information

Fill-up all mandatory information. All First year students shall type their 'JEE Mains Merit number' inside type-box. Rest of the students shall type their 'MIS/Roll number' inside type-box. All students shall type their full name starting with 'First name' without any mistake. Fill-up all other mandatory fields and press the 'Submit' button. Verify the details and press 'Confirm' button only if all the data filled is correct. It will take you to payment gateway page.

Making of Payment

The different ways and respective procedures for paying fees through online SBI Collect are described as below:

A. Through Internet Banking

It is the most promising method of payment and IIIT Pune prefer you to go for this option. On the payment gateway there's tab of 'Net Banking' in which you will find two options 'State Bank of India' and 'Other Banks Internet Banking'. Select your bank from drop-box and follow the regular payment process. Kindly note that SBI collect will charge you processing fee (additional charges).

After completion online receipt gets generated. A copy of that receipt must be submitted at the time of admission.

B. Through Credit Card

It is also a promising payment method but the processing fee charges for this method are comparatively huge and differ from bank to bank. On the payment gateway there's tab of 'Card Payments' in which you will find an option 'Credit Cards'. Note that there's no other option (such as Debit Card etc.) available. Select your bank from drop-box and follow the regular payment process.

After completion online receipt gets generated. A copy of that receipt must be submitted at the time of admission.

C. Through NEFT/RTGS

If you don't have Internet Banking/Credit Card facility available on your account, you may use this payment option. You should bring **your cheque-book** along with you. You should generate e-challan by selecting 'NEFT/RTGS' option from 'Other Payment Modes' tab. At the bottom you will find a link to download pdf of your e-challan as given below:

After click on the above link, your e-challan in '.PDF' format will get generated. You should take a print of that form and go to nearby branch of that bank in which you are having your account. You should visit the concern authority to make your payment through NEFT/RTGS by using your cheque. However, IIIT Pune does not prefer this method as there might have chances of non-cooperation of respective banks. It is advisable that you may enquire about the availability of such facility at any of its branches from your home branch before leaving your place. IIIT Pune is not responsible for any such non-compliance issue from bank. Kindly note that SBI collect will charge you processing fee (additional charges).

After completion you will get receipt of your transaction with a seal of bank. A copy of that receipt must be submitted at the time of admission.

D. Through Cash

IIIT Pune as a leading national importance Institute does not prefer to use this method as we support and believe in Digital India concept. However if you don't have Internet Banking/Credit Card facility/Cheque-book available on your account, you may use this payment option. You should generate e-challan by selecting 'SBI Branch' option from 'Other Payment Modes' tab. At the bottom you will find a link to download pdf of your e-challan as given below:

After click on the above link, your e-challan in '.PDF' format will get generated. You should take a print of that form and go to nearby SBI branch (SBI branch is available in College of Engineering Campus itself) along with cash. You should visit the concern authority to make your

payment through Cash. . Kindly note that SBI collect will charge you processing fee (additional charges).

After completion you will get receipt of your transaction with a seal of bank. A copy of that receipt must be submitted at the time of admission.
